What is Pre-apprenticeship?

- Recognized by the Bureau of Labor & Industry (BOLI)
- A program that prepares people who want to eventually enroll in a **registered** apprenticeship program
- It provides insight into apprenticeable occupations and develops basic trade skills
- A way to recruit underrepresented populations to apprenticeship





Who is it for?

A Youth Pre-apprenticeship is for
High School Juniors and Seniors



UCC's Youth Pre-apprenticeship Program



- Funded by a Youth Development Division (YDD) grant, in partnership with Bright Futures Umpqua
- Pre-apprenticeship Coordinator: Amanda Clark
- Four participating High Schools:
Elkton Charter School, Roseburg High School, Phoenix School and Douglas High School



UCC's BOLI Approved Program

- These partners pledged to provide preference points towards the application process or hiring to those that successfully complete the pre-apprenticeship program





How do Students Complete?

Required:

High School Diploma/GED completion with

- APR 101 Intro to the Trades (dual credit)
- One-year of trade technology classes
- First Aid/CPR & OSHA 10
- Oregon Driver's License or Oregon ID Card
- Resume/Cover Letter





How do Student Complete? (continued)

Completion of three or more activities (examples):

- Attend Southern Oregon Trade Expo, Women in Welding, or other trade related event
- Attend an UCC Career Event
- Choose 3 trades/report on min. qualifications
- Practice interview with a Trades/CTE Instructor
- Conduct interview with a registered apprentice or employer



What do Completers Earn?



- Completion Certificate from Bureau of Labor & Industry (BOLI)
- Preference points towards entering an apprenticeship, or being hired by a company that runs an employer sponsored apprenticeship
