



Career and Technical Education: Program Specific Accreditations and Approvals





Emergency Medical Services

State Accreditation

- The Education Division of the Office of Community College and Workforce Development (CCWD)
- Required by Oregon Administrative Rules
- Reviewed on a five year cycle
 - Reaffirmed in 2017
 - No areas of concern





Emergency Medical Services

National Accreditation

- The Commission on Accreditation of Allied Health Education Programs (CAAHEP), that accredits upon the recommendation of the Committee on Accreditation of Educational Programs for the Emergency Medical Services Professions (CoAEMSP)
- Required for students to sit for the national certification exams
- Reviewed on a five year cycle
 - Reaffirmed in 2019
 - Areas of concern



General Automotive



National Accreditation

- The National Automotive Technicians Education Foundation (NATEF)
 - Required in order to offer the multiple national programs and certifications at UCC
 - Reviewed on a five year cycle
 - Reaffirmed in 2018
 - Mid cycle review in 2021
 - No areas of concern

Additional certifications and approvals

- Career Automotive Program-Local (CAP-Local), Snap-On, and Subaru University all require additional review and certification





Toyota Technician Training and Education Network (Toyota T-TEN)

National Accreditation

- The National Automotive Technicians Education Foundation (NATEF)
 - Required to offer the Toyota T-TEN program
 - Reviewed on a five year cycle
 - Reaffirmed in 2018
 - Mid-cycle review in 2021
 - No areas of concern
- Other accreditations and certifications
 - Accredited by Toyota Motor North America and the Toyota T-TEN Instructor Community
 - Contract renewed every two years





Dental Assisting

National Accreditation

- The Commission on Dental Accreditation (CODA)
 - Voluntary process
 - Accredits dental and dental-related education programs at the post-secondary level
 - Reviewed on a seven year cycle
 - Initial accreditation in 2015





Registered Nursing (RN)

State Approval

- Oregon State Board of Nursing (OSBN)
 - Mandated by Oregon Administrative Rules Chapter 851, Division 21
 - Varying lengths of OSBN approval, depending on outcome of approval process (three, five, or eight year)
 - Reaffirmed in 2019
 - Eight year approval awarded
 - Areas of concern





Nursing Assistant 1 (NA1)

State Approval

- Oregon State Board of Nursing (OSBN)
 - Mandated by OAR Chapter 851, Division 21
 - Maximum of a two year approval
 - Reaffirmed in 2019
 - Two year approval awarded
 - Areas of concern
