



# CARES Act Funding FY21

**Introduction:** *The Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act or, CARES Act, was passed by Congress and signed by the President on March 27th, 2020.*

- 50% of funding or \$560,927 was provided as financial aid to students in FY 20 as required by Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund
- 50% of funding or \$560,926 was provided to the College to cover “significant change to the delivery of instruction due to coronavirus”.

# CRRSAA Funding FY21

**Introduction:** *The Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund II (HEERF II) is authorized by the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA), Public Law 116-260, signed into law by the President on Dec. 27, 2020.*

- Congress expanded the allowable uses for supplemental awards and new awards made under section 314(a)(1) of the CRRSAA and for unspent CARES Act funds, subject to certain limitations.
