



Dear UCC Campus Community,

In our continued commitment to keep you informed regarding UCC activity involving COVID-19, here are current College updates (as of Tuesday, April 21).

State leaders are working on an overarching strategy to gradually reopen the state. This will happen in a phase-by-phase process. The framework for reopening will draw from the national framework, which is a health-based, science-based approach. Gov. Brown is working with health experts on a potential, [multi-phased approach](#). **As a reminder, all current restrictions regarding the UCC campus are in effect through June 11, per the governor's current executive order.**

Here is the latest information regarding UCC:

- Based on what we know at this time, the College plans on offering courses in summer and fall by remote delivery and online, with the hope that CTE programs will be allowed by the state to have limited face-to-face instruction. But stay tuned! Everyone needs to recognize that the situation is fluid and changes may come as the course of COVID-19 changes.
- The student trip to Indonesia that was tentatively rescheduled for June has been canceled. The current hope is that the trip will be able to take place next March, with a final decision (hopefully) by October.
- The commencement ceremony scheduled for June 12 has been canceled. The decision was made following feedback from roughly 30 students. Two alternate options include holding an in-person ceremony in September (pending the governor's actions) or having a virtual ceremony. More information will be shared moving forward.
- The quarterly Blood Drive originally scheduled on campus has been moved to the Douglas County YMCA. Signups are desperately needed for the Tuesday, April 28 event. Blood drives are being cancelled at rapid rates, but healthy individuals are needed to donate. To make an appointment, call 541-440-4600 or email Mentor5@umpqua.edu. All donors are now required to wear face masks to their donation. If you do not have a mask, one will be provided for you. - Work continues on the CARES Act disbursements for students. All colleges are awaiting a few final pieces of information from the U.S. Department of Education (DOE). As it stands, UCC has potentially identified 2,346 students who may be eligible to receive the funding. When disbursements happen, the amounts will vary based on each student's full-time or part-time status. Students will be notified as soon as the DOE confirms disbursement parameters.

- Reminder: UCC's Life Coach is available to provide current students with brief personal counseling, health and wellness support, case management, and resource connection. Zoom Virtual Appointments, which are available Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., can be made by logging in and scheduling within [AdvisorTrac](#). Once you schedule an appointment, make sure to check your student email for a meeting link and directions.
