



Sexual Harassment, Discrimination & Misconduct Report Form (Title IX)

If you were a victim of sexual violence, please consider your safety first.

1. Find a safe location away from the accused. Ask a trusted friend to be with you for support.
2. Call 911.
3. Seek medical assistance.

Individuals who seek to make a complaint or report, may:

1. Request interim safety and support measures.
2. File a complaint with the Title IX Coordinator, thereby invoking the College's "Responding to Harassment Based on Sex under Title IX" process, Mary Flaherty, Compliance Officer / Title IX Coordinator at (541) 440-7763, TTY/TDD 440-4612, Mary.Flaherty@umpqua.edu, Sue Shaffer Learning Commons & Library, 1140 Umpqua College Road, Roseburg, Oregon 97470.
3. Contact the Campus Security Office, (541) 440-7777, for assistance in filing a criminal complaint and preserving physical evidence.
4. Contact law enforcement to file a criminal complaint.

Reporting Party Information

A report may be completed confidentially by omitting the reporter's name and contact information from the form. However, the reporting party should be aware that this may restrict the ability to complete a thorough investigation. UCC strictly prohibits any attempt to seek retribution against an individual or group of individuals involved in filing a report or complaint, participating in the disciplinary process, or opposing an action believed to constitute a violation of College policy.
